Entry allowed for qualified junior riders.

Qualifying for a Championship as per current NAMEF Equitation Rules:

8.1. For the Namibia Equitation Championship an Open test will be applicable.

8.2. Qualification Restrictions:

8.2.1. The rider must have competed in at least 3 equitation competitions, of which one must have been an official SANEF test.

8.2.2. Rider must have achieved grading points in equitation

8.3. How the champion is determined:

8.3.1. A championship will be held once in a year by a club who has applied for the championship.

8.3.2. From the grading list the top 3 qualification points are added to give a preliminary Total.

8.3.3. The result of the championship counts double points.

8.3.4. The sum of the championship points and the preliminary points determine the winner.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Competitions will be ridden according to Rules and Regulations of FEI and NAMEF.
2. Fees: Competitions: See for each competition
Stabling fee: N\$ 40-00 for the show.
First Aid standby: N\$ 50-00 per rider
3. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on the club premises.
4. A horses must be accompanied by a valid horse passport and be vaccinated against African Horse Sickness and Equine Influenza.
5. All horses and riders must be registered with NAMEF or another federation member of the FEI. Proof may be requested by the organizers.
6. Stabling will be available as from Friday, 17 September 2010. No horse feed or bedding is available at the club.
7. Horse trailers and/or lorries may only be parked at places allocated by the Organizing Committee
8. Neither the organizers, nor NAMEF or their officials can be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by horse, rider, the public or their property.
9. No showers are available on the premises.
10. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to:
 - a. cancel any of the programmed competitions, should too few entries be received for such competition(s).
 - b. combine two or more competitions into one competition, with or without handicap
 - c. postpone or cancel the tournament in part or totality, in case of unforeseen and/or special circumstances.
