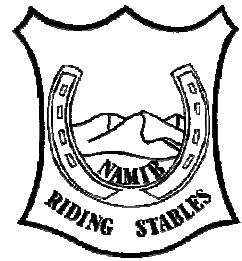

RIDING ABILITY / SPECIAL COMPETITIONS

- 1. Lead Rein Riding Ability Test – NOT GRADED**
Open for all children beginner riders who still ride on a lead rein during lessons and who have never participated in any Riding Ability Test, Dressage Test or Jumping Competition at any official show.
- 2. Standard Riding Ability Test – NOT GRADED**
Open for children beginner riders who have not won any Riding Ability Test, or have never won or have never been placed in any Dressage / Equitation Test or Jumping Competition at any official show. Martingale or side reins are permitted.
- 3. Beginner Jumping 0.60m – NOT GRADED NAMEF 2.7.1.1 AM7**
- 4. Babbalas Speed and Precision Jumping 0.80m – NOT GRADED & for adults only NAMEF 2.7.5.1**

CHILDREN'S DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS

- 5. Pony Riders Test P2, (SANEF 2007), 20 x 40 arena**
Open to level CP Children riders on any horse.
Open to level CP horses with any children rider.
- 6. Pony Riders Test N3, (SANEF 2007), 20 x 40 arena**
Open to level CN Children riders on any horse.
Open to level CN horses with any children rider.

JUNIOR & ADULT DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS

- 7. Preliminary Test 2, (SANEF – 2009), 20x60 arena**
Open to level P Junior or Adult riders on any horse.
Open to level P horses with any Junior or Adult rider.
- 8. Novice Test 4, (SANEF – 2009), 20x60 arena**
Open to level P or N Junior or Adult riders on any horse.
Open to level P or N horses with any Junior or Adult rider.

9. **Elementary Test 3**, (SANEF – 2009), 20x60 arena
Open to level N or E Junior or Adult riders on any horse, N grade or higher
Open to level N or E horses with any Junior or Adult rider N grade or higher
10. **Elementary Medium Test 5**, (SANEF – 2009), 20x60 arena
Open to level E and EM Junior or Adult riders on any horse, E grade or higher
Open to level E and EM horses with any Junior or Adult rider, E grade or higher

EQUITATION JUMPING COMPETITIONS

32. **Equitation Children** NAMEF Equitation Test 13 - 80cm
Open to all riders up to the age of 14 on ANY horse (with change of Horse)
33. **Equitation Juniors** NAMEF Equitation Test 13 - 90cm
Open to all riders between the age of 14 and 18 on ANY horse (with change of Horse)
34. **Equitation Adults** NAMEF Equitation Test 13 - 1.00m
Open to all riders from the age of 18 on ANY horse (with change of Horse)

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All horses and riders participating in any graded competition have to be registered with NAMEF or any other federation affiliated to the FEI prior to the entry closing date of the Tournament. International Riders must provide proof of registration with their National Federation. Riders and horses participating in events 1, 2, 3 and 4 only, do not have to be registered with NAMEF but should be registered with a Club affiliated to NAMEF or NERA.

All riders should familiarise themselves with the article 1.19 (Veterinary Matters) as per the NAMEF Rules and Regulations 4th Edition 2007.

1. All competitions will be ridden according to rules and Regulations of FEI and NAMEF (Refer to www.namef.org)

2. All horses must be in possession of a valid and up to date Horse Passport, and be vaccinated up to date against African Horse Sickness and Equine Influenza. The organisers reserve the right to request the owner/rider to produce the Horse passport of any horse participating in the show or brought onto the premises of NRS.
3. Closing Date for entries is 21 May 2010.
4. The Stabling Fee will be N\$50-00 per horse for the duration of the tournament (i.e. Friday and Saturday night). Any added day required will be charged additionally at N\$25-00 per night. **Any early arrivals and / or late departures must be noted on the entry form.** Competitors must supply their own food, grass, water troughs, buckets and bedding for horses.

Stabling at NRS will be allocated on 'first come, first serve' basis. Detailed stable plans will be displayed at NRS prior to the show.

5. **ENTRY FEES:** For each class entered : N\$40-00

If an event is cancelled due to weather, an alternative event will take place instead as to still award prizes. Entry fees for events cancelled due to weather are non-refundable.

6. Neither NAMEF, NRS, their officials, sponsors or representatives nor the organizers shall in any way be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by horses, riders, the public or their property at the show, caused by, or resulting from this show.

7. **Dogs brought to the premises of the Namib Riding Stables must be kept on a leash AT ALL TIMES.**

8. Riding "Out of Competition", also for adults, in any of the programmed events, will be allowed in accordance with the provisions of NAMEF Regulation No. 1.9.

9. The organisers reserve the right to:

- 10.1 Cancel any of the programmed competitions, should too few entries be received for such an event or competition;
- 10.2 Combine two or more competitions into one, with or without handicap for higher grades;
- 10.3 Amend the time schedule mentioned in the programmed events;
- 10.4 Change the starting order of riders in competitions in case of need; and
- 10.5 Postpone or cancel the tournament in part or totally, in case of unforeseen and /or special circumstances.

10. **A FEE OF N\$80-00 PER RIDER IS COMPULSORY FOR FIRST AID SERVICES AND MUST BE ADDED TO THE TOTAL ENTRY FEE.**

11. **ENTRY FORMS:**

The attached entry form must be completed in full (including, the date of birth of the relevant rider). Payment must be made to: **Namib Riding Stables**, preferably by bank deposit or direct bank transfer. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by proof of payment:

Telephonic entries or entries unaccompanied by the correct entry fees will not be accepted.

Late Entries after 21 May 2010 will only be accepted at double the entry fee. Although the organisers aim to include all late entries in the program, this can only be done up to a certain period.

12. Tack, bits and clothing must comply with the relevant NAMEF Rules and Regulations.
13. Each club with children or juniors competing at this show, must nominate in writing one adult who is responsible for controlling their children and juniors. Riding clubs are requested to bring along their club banner for the closing parade.
14. Horse trailers or trucks may only be parked at places as allocated by the organising committee on the stable plan which will be displayed at the club prior to the show.
15. Riders entering more than one horse in a competition may choose the starting order of his/her horses. Please indicate starting order on the entry form.
16. Prizes shall consist of donated items and / or prize money.

Bar and kitchen will be open for refreshments!!!

A social braai, with braai packs for sale, will be held on Saturday, 5 June 2010 starting at 18h00 in the tent. If you would like to join us for the braai please let us know so that we have an estimate for catering purposes.
