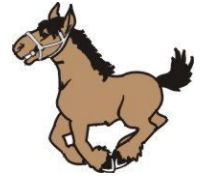

| <b>10. Competition for Newcomers (not graded) -</b><br>Open to all riders who have not competed in an equitation competition on a show<br>Only one horse per rider allowed. Riders of all ages allowed<br>No change of horses   | <b>NAMEF Equitation Test2, 60cm</b> | N\$ 20,-  |
| <b>11. Best turned out horse and rider (not graded)</b><br>Prepare your horse and yourself for going on a show.<br>A panel of judges will evaluate the appearance of horse and rider, cleanliness, clothing and riding gear.<br>This is NOT fancy dress, but how you would go to a show.<br>The participant will ride the horse in the arena in a walk, trot and canter.<br>No jumping required.<br>All Age groups are welcome.   |                                     | N\$ 15,-  |
| <b>12. Best combination horse and rider (not graded)</b><br>The rider will have to manage a specific course of obstacles not higher than 50cm.<br>A panel of judges will mark the correctness in managing the course and communication between horse and rider.<br>All Age groups are welcome.  |                                     | N\$ 15,-  |
| <b>13. Pair Jumping Event (not graded)</b><br>A team consists of <b>any 2</b> riders.<br>The team has to manage a course of obstacles <b>together</b> .<br>Maximum of 10 points will be given for the unity and general picture<br>2 Points will be added for each obstacle which is cleared correctly by both riders.<br>If one horse refuses, both riders have to approach the jump again.<br>No points will be awarded for a jump knocked down.<br>On equality of points the faster time will decide the placing.<br>All Age groups are welcome. | <b>Rule: own , 60cm</b>             | No Charge |

## **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Competitions will be ridden according to Rules and Regulations of FEI and NAMEF.
2. Fees:

Competitions	See for each competition
Stabling fee	N\$ 40-00 for the show.
First Aid standby	N\$ 35-00 (50) per rider.
3. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on the club premises.
4. All horses must be accompanied by a valid horse passport and be vaccinated against African Horse Sickness and Equine Influenza. Except for the Open Competitions 10, 11, 12 and 13, all horses and riders must be registered with NAMEF or another federation member of the FEI. Proof may be requested by the organizers.
5. No showers are available on the premises.
6. Stabling will be available for horses from outside Windhoek first. If enough stables are available, Windhoek horses will also be stabled. Stabling is available as from Friday, 19 February 2010. No horse feed or bedding is available at the club.
7. Horse trailers and/or lorries may only be parked at places allocated by the Organizing Committee.
8. Neither the organizers, nor NAMEF or their officials can be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by horse, rider, the public or their property.
9. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to:
  - a. cancel any of the programmed competitions, should too few entries be received for such competition(s).
  - b. combine two or more competitions into one competition, with or without handicap
  - c. postpone or cancel the tournament in part or totality, in case of unforeseen and/or special circumstances.
