**Entry closing date: 4<sup>th</sup> of July 2010**

### **Special Competitions for Beginners** (Riders / Horses do not have to register with NAMEF – not graded)

1. **Riding Ability Test Lead Reign**  
Open for all beginner athletes under the age of 7 years, who still ride on a lead during lessons and who have NEVER participated in any Riding Ability test or Jumping competition at any official show. Martingale or side reins are permitted. **Trot or Canter not compulsory. Neat outfit, knowledge of horse/riding is of advantage. The competition will only start if we have more than 3 riders.**
2. **Standard Riding Ability Test**  
Open for Riders who have not won any Riding Ability Test, or have not competed in any Dressage/ Equitation Test at any Official Show. Martingale or side reins are permitted.
3. **Dressage Test Pony Riders Preliminary 1 2010 –Arena 20 x 40m**  
Open for riders who haven't competed in any dressage / equitation test at any official show.

  - Open to horse and rider combinations that are permitted in 90cm/100cm jumping competitions (height 1.00m)
  - Open to horse and rider combinations that are permitted in 110cm/120cm/130cm jumping competitions (height 1.20m - handicap 1.30m)

## ***General Rules and Regulations***

### **Riders & horses taking part in the special competition for the beginners do not have to be registered with NAMEF**

Riding Ability Lead reign are young riders under the age of 7 years.

For all other competition horses and Riders have to be registered with NAMEF or another member Federation of the FEI **prior to the entry closing date of the show**. Riders must provide proof of registration with their National Federation.

All entry forms from members of another Federation must be signed by their Federations secretary. NERA members have to complete a NAMEF registration form (no fee applicable) and submit to the NAMEF grading secretary; all horses have to be registered with NAMEF.

All riders should familiarize themselves with the article 1.19 (Veterinary Matters) as per the NAMEF Rules and Regulations 4<sup>th</sup> Edition 2007.

1. All competitions will be ridden according to rules and Regulations of the FEI and NAMEF (Refer to [www.namef.org](http://www.namef.org).)
2. All horses must be in possession of a valid and up to date Horse Passport, and be vaccinated up to date against African Horse sickness and Equine Influenza.
3. Closing Date for entries is 4 July 2010
4. Stabling of horses:  
**The Stabling Fee will be N\$ 40-00 per horse** for the duration of the tournament (i.e. Friday, Saturday and Sunday night). Any additional day required will be charged additionally at N\$20-00 per night. Any early arrivals and / or late departures must be noted on the entry form.

Competitors must supply their own feeding, grass, water troughs and bedding for horses.

**A FEE OF N\$ 40- 00 PER RIDER IS COMPULSORY FOR FIRST AID SERVICE AND MUST BE ADDED TO THE TOTAL ENTRY FEE.**

#### **ENTRY FEES:**

**Children /Juniors /Adults N\$30-** (per competition)

**First Aid N\$40-** (per rider)

**Stabling N\$40-** (per horse for the duration of the show)

5. Officials cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by horses, riders, the general public and / or their property.
6. Dogs brought to the premises of the Reitgemeinschaft Otjiwarongo must be kept on a leash AT ALL TIMES.
7. The organizer reserved the right to:
  - 7.1 cancel any of the programmed competitions, should too few entries be received for such event or competitions;
  - 7.2 combine two or more competitions into one, with or without handicap for higher grades;  
Amend the time schedule mentioned in the programmed events;  
Change the starting order of riders in competitions in case of need; and
  - 7.3 postpone or cancel the tournament in part or totally, in case of unforeseen and /or special circumstances.

No cross entries allowed.

Tacks and Bits must comply with the relevant NAMEF Rules and Regulations.

Riding clubs are requested to bring along their club banner for the closing parade.

Horse trailers or trucks may only be parked at places allocated by the organizing committee.

**Private accommodation cannot be arranged.** If caravan and / or tent space is required, this has to be indicated on the entry form.

**If more than one horse is entered in a competition, the starting order must be stated on the entry form.** NAMEF Restrictions: see NAMEF rules and regulation

### **Return of floating Trophies:**

**Floating trophies have to be returned by the latest on 23rd of July 2010 in a clean and polished condition.**

### **Prizes:**

Prizes shall consist of either or both donated items and / or prize money.
