Open to level D5 and D6 riders on any horse with grading D6 or higher e.g. D5

Open to level D4 and D5 riders on any horse with grading D5 or higher e.g. D4

General Rules and Regulations

All horses and Riders have to be registered with NAMEF or another member Federation of the FEI prior to the entry closing date of the show (except participants of the Ridings Ability Test- For P dressage all riders and horses must be registered). International Riders must provide proof of registration with their National Federation.

All riders should familiarize themselves with the article 1.19 (Veterinary Matters) as per the NAMEF Rules and Regulations 4th Edition 2007.

1. All competitions will be ridden according to rules and Regulations of FEI and NAMEF (Refer to www.Namef.org.)
2. All horses must be in possession of a valid and up to date Horse Passport, and be vaccinated up to date against African Horsesickness and Equine Influenza.
3. Closing Date for entries is 13th July 2009
4. Stabling of horses:
The Stabling Fee will be N\$ 40-00 per horse for the duration of the tournament (i.e. Friday ,Saturday and Sunday night). Any additional day required will be charged additionally at N\$20-00 per night.
Any early arrivals and / or late departures must be noted on the entry form.

Competitors must supply their own feeding, grass, water troughs and bedding for horses.

5. Officials cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by horses, riders, the general public and / or their property.
6. Dogs brought to the premises of the Reitgemeinschaft Otjiwarongo must be kept on a leash AT ALL TIMES.
7. Riding `out of competition` , also for adults, in any of the programmed events, will be allowed in accordance with the provisions of NAMEF Regulation No. 1.9.
9. The organizer reserves the right to:

- 9.1 cancel any of the programmed competitions, should too few entries be received for such event or competitions;
- 9.2 combine two or more competitions into one, with or without handicap for higher grades; amend the time schedule mentioned in the programmed events; change the starting order of riders in competitions in case of need; and
- 9.3 postpone or cancel the tournament in part or totally, in case of unforeseen and /or special circumstances.

A FEE OF N\$ 40- 00 PER RIDER IS COMPULSORY OF FIRST AID SERVICE AND MUST BE ADDED TO THE TOTAL ENTRY FEE.

- Late Entries (after 13 July 2009) will not be accepted, unless double the relevant entry fee .
- No cross entries allowed.
- Tacks and Bits must comply with the relevant Namef Rules and Regulations
- Each club having children or juniors competing at this show , must nominate in writing one adult who is responsible for controlling their children and juniors.
- Riding clubs are requested to bring along their club banner for the closing parade.
- Horse trailers or trucks may only be parked at places allocated by the organizing committee.
- **Private accommodation cannot be arranged** . If caravan and / or tent space is required, this has to be indicated on the entry form.
- **If more than one horse is entered in a competition , the starting order must be stated on the entry form.**
- Age Restrictions: see NAMEF rules and regulation

Return of floating trophies:

Floating trophies have to be returned by the latest on th 24 of July 2009 in a clean and polished condition.

Prizes:

Prizes shall consist of either or both donated items and / or prize money.

DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS

1. In Dressage: * Children will participate in their own competitions
 * Juniors and Adults will participate in one competition
2. Riders and horses are graded in relation to levels. P-Dressage tests will also be graded.
3. The following table is **currently** applicable to all dressage competitions in a schedule, unless differently stated for the competition itself.

(D - indicates DRESSAGE)

Level D7:	P-dressage	Open to all level-D7 riders on any horse Open to all level-D7 horses with any rider
Level D6:	N-dressage	Open to all level-D6 riders on any horse being level-D6 or higher Open to all level-D6 horses with any rider being level-D6 or higher
Level D5:	E-Dressage	Open to all level-D5 riders on any horse being level-D5 or higher Open to all level-D5 horses with any rider being level-D5 or higher
Level D4:	E/M Dressage	Open to all level-D4 riders on any horse being level-D4 or higher Open to all level-D4 horses with any rider being level-D4 or higher
Level D3:	M-Dressage	Open to all level-D3 riders on any horse being level-D3 or higher Open to all level-D3 horses with any rider being level-D3 or higher
Level D2:	Advanced higher	Open to all riders being level-D3 or higher on any horse being Level-D3 or higher

JUMPING COMPETITIONS

1. Jumping competitions are not divided by age groups anymore, but separated in height of jumps.
2. ALL Age groups will participate in one competition, unless otherwise stated in the competition, e.g. championships or fun events
3. Riders and horses are graded in relation to levels.
4. The following table is **currently** applicable to all jumping competitions in a schedule, unless differently stated for the competition itself.

(J - indicates JUMPING)

Level J9:	70cm	Open to all level-J9 riders on any horse Open to all level-J9 horses with any rider
Level J8	80cm	Open to all level-J8 riders on any horse being level-J8 or higher Open to all level-J8 horses with any rider being level-J8 or higher
Level J7	90cm	Open to all level-J7 riders on any horse being level-J7 or higher Open to all level-J7 horses with any rider being level-J7 or higher
Level J6	1.00m	Open to all level-J6 riders on any horse being level-J6 or higher Open to all level-J6 horses with any rider being level-J6 or higher
Level J5	1.10m	Open to all level-J5 riders on any horse being level-J5 or higher Open to all level-J5 horses with any rider being level-J5 or higher
Level J4	1.20m	Open to all riders being level-J4 or higher on any horse being level-J4 or higher Open to all horses being level-J4 or higher with any rider being level-J4 or higher

All horses with level-3 or higher will compete with a handicap.

Horses AND Riders are graded according to the applicable Level (Leistungs Klasse).

NOTES:

- Any horse MAY be ridden by different riders during one show.
- Only in level-D7 competitions (P-dressage) and level-J9 competitions (70cm) may the same horse start with more than 1 (one) rider.
- A horse MAY NOT start more than 4 times in one day.
