**NOTES:**

- 1. All NAMEF and FEI Rules shall apply. Telephonic or entries unaccompanied by the correct entry fees will NOT be accepted. Late Entry's must be accompanied by DOUBLE the Entry Fee, and will not appear in the Program!**
- 2. Classes: 70cm-1.30m, P-EM, Nov & Intermediate Equitation are open to full members of NAMEF, or another National Federation. All entry forms from members of another Federation must be signed by their Federations secretary. NERA members have to complete a NAMEF registration form (no fee applicable) and submit to the NAMEF grading secretary; all horses have to be registered with NAMEF.**  
**Classes: 60cm Jumping, Riding Ability, Fun Competitions are open to members of any Registered Riding Club. Horses and Riders do not have to be registered with NAMEF. These Classes will not receive Cash Prize Money, only vouchers/gifts.**
- 4. Tack, Bits and Clothing must comply with the relevant NAMEF Rules & Regulations.**
- 5. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel, combine and restrict classes. Amend the time schedule mentioned in the program. Change the starting order of Riders and their Horses in case of need. Postpone or cancel the show in part or totally, in case of unforeseen and/or special circumstances**
- 6. All horses must be accompanied by their updated Horse Passports, which should be available for inspection at any given time.**
- 7. All Dogs must be on leads.**
- 8. Catering will be available.**

TIME RELAY

(This fun event will consist of a combination of Barrel Racing, Pole Bending "Slalom", Dog Agility, Mom/Dad/Groom Race, Sack Race, Potato Race, "Topf Schlagen" and Apple Fishing)

**RULES:** The order of the Races will be decided at the Tournament

Barrel Race- time/fault's count to complete Barrels (Rider/Horse combination)

Pole Bending- time counts to complete Poles (Rider/Horse combination)

Dog Agility- time/fault's count to complete Agility Track (Dog/Handler combination)

Mom/Dad/Groom Race- Fun track time counts to complete Track (Mom or Dad or Groom combined with Horse or Stock Perd)

Potato Race- Balance/time counts to complete Track (Mom/Dad/Groom/Friend or Rider)

"Topf Schlagen"- Find the Pot and Hit it with a Wooden Spoon Blindfolded (Mom/Dad/Groom/Friend or Rider)

Sack Race- time counts to complete Track (Mom/Dad/Groom/Friend or Rider)

Apple Fishing- Fish Apple out of Bucket of Water, hands on Back (Mom/Dad/Groom/Friend/Dog/Horse or Rider)
