STABLING:	On a first come first serve basis at N\$20.00 per horse per night.
GRASS:	Available at N\$45.00 per bale (limited Bales available)
BEDDING:	Per Bag of Shavings N\$10.00 (limited Bags available)

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 1. All NAMEF and FEI Rules shall apply. Telephonic or entries unaccompanied by the correct entry fees will NOT be accepted. Late Entry's must be accompanied by DOUBLE the Entry Fee, and will not appear in the Program!**
- 2. Classes: P to EM Dressage's are open to members of NAMEF, or another National Federation. The Championships are open to riders with Namibian Citizenship and riders from abroad residing in Namibia, see FEI GR Article 123. All entry forms from members of another Federation must be signed by their Federations secretary. Classes: Fun Competitions and non-graded Competitions are open to members of any Club. Horses and Riders do not have to be registered with NAMEF. These Classes will not receive Cash Prize Money, only vouchers/gifts.**
- 3. Horses competing in the show have preference in stable allocations above non-participating horses.**

4. **NO Shavings may be taken from the shaving bay unless supervised by a RVS Committee member.**
5. **Horse trailers and trucks may only be parked in areas allocated by the Organizing Committee.**
6. **Camping on or in the vicinity of the stable grounds is prohibited. Grooms may stay in trailers.**
7. **Any horse may not compete more than 4 times a day in a Graded Competition, including the FEI competitions.**
8. **Riding out of competition "Hors Concours" in any of the programmed classes, will be permitted in accordance with the NAMEF Rules and Regulations.**
9. **Tack, Bits and Clothing must comply with the relevant NAMEF Rules & Regulations.**
- 11a. **The Organizers reserve the right to cancel, combine and restrict classes.**
- 11b. **Amend the time schedule mentioned in the program.**
- 11c. **Change the starting order of Riders and their Horses in case of need.**
- 11d. **Postpone or cancel the show in part or totally, in case of unforeseen and/or special circumstances.**
12. **Riders Withdrawing from a Competition have to do this in accordance with the NAMEF Rules and Regulations 1.12.3.1.1, 1.12.3.1.3 & 1.12.3.1.4. No-shows will not be refunded any portion of their entry fees.**

RULES & REGULATIONS CONTINUED

13. **All horses must be accompanied by their updated Horse Passports, which should be available for inspection at any given time.**
14. **All Dogs must be on leads at all times.**
15. **Catering will be available.**

Neither NAMEF, RVS, the show jumping body, its officials or representatives as well as the organizers shall in any way be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by horses, riders, the public or their property at the show, caused by, or resulting from this show.

NAMIBIAN CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- a) The Championships shall not be staged, nor prizes awarded unless at least 2 entries are received and 2 horses compete in each Championship Class
- b) The Championship shall not be classified as official, nor Prizes awarded, unless the winner achieved at least 55% or above of the total marks available.
- c) The order of riding for the 3rd Test will be determined by the reverse order of results of the Qualifying Tests. The lowest mark starts first and the best to start last.
- d) In the event of equality of points in the Championship, then the 3rd test mark will decide the better placing.
- e) All Championship Classes are Graded except the Musical Freestyles for Junior and Adults.
