## **JUMPING COMPETITIONS**

1. Jumping competitions are not divided by age groups anymore, but separated in height of jumps.
2. ALL Age groups will participate in one competition, unless otherwise stated in the competition, e.g. championships or fun events
3. Riders and horses are graded in relation to levels.
4. The following table is **currently** applicable to all jumping competitions in a schedule, unless differently stated for the competition itself.

<b>70cm</b>	Open to all level-70CM riders on any horse Open to all level-70CM horses with any rider
<b>80cm</b>	Open to all level-80CM riders on any horse being level-80CM or higher Open to all level-80CM horses with any rider being level-80CM or higher
<b>90cm</b>	Open to all level-90 CM riders on any horse being level-90 CM or higher Open to all level-90 CM horses with any rider being level-90 CM or higher
<b>1.00m</b>	Open to all level-100 CM riders on any horse being level-100 CM or higher Open to all level-100 CM horses with any rider being level-100 CM or higher
<b>1.10m</b>	Open to all level-110 CM riders on any horse being level-110 CM or higher Open to all level-110 CM horses with any rider being level-110 CM or higher
<b>1.20m</b>	Open to all level-120 CM riders with any horse being level-120 CM or higher Open to all level-120 CM horses with any rider being level-120 CM or higher
<b>1.30m</b>	Open to all level-130 CM rider with any horse being level-130 CM or higher Open to all level-130 CM horses with any rider being level-130 CM or higher

**Horses AND Riders are graded according to the applicable Level (Leistungs Klasse).**

### **NOTES:**

- Any horse MAY be ridden by different riders during one show.
- Only in P DRESSAGE competitions and 70cm Jumping competitions may the same horse start with more than 1 (one) rider.
- A horse MAY NOT start more than 4 times in one day.
