REIT CLUB OKAHANDJA - 8 & 9 SEPTEMBER 2007

ENTRIES CLOSE: **13 AUGUST 2007**

1. BEGINNER JUMPING COMPETITION – 60CM (RULE AM 8)
2. BEGINNER JUMPING COMPETITION – 70CM (RULE AM 7)
3. BEGINNER JUMPING COMPETITION – 80CM (RULE AM 7)

Open to all (Competitions 1 – 3): Rosettes only. Horses competing in no. 1 – 3 (except school horses) may not start in any other jumping competitions except competition no. 28. Horses & riders competing in competitions no. 1 – 3 do not have to be registered with NAMEF.

CHILDREN'S COMPETITIONS:

4. RIDING ABILITY TEST:

Open to children who have not won a riding ability test more than two times (maximum) and who have not been placed in any Dressage/Jumping or Equitation competition. Open to horses of any grading. Running and/or standing martingale or side-reins permitted. Will be divided into different age groups if sufficient riders have entered. Horses & riders competing in competitions no. 4 do not have to be registered with NAMEF.

5. PRELIM DRESSAGE SANEF 2007 PONY RIDERS P2 - Open to all CN horses 0-5 points and beginner riders on any children horse.
6. NOVICE DRESSAGE SANEF 2007 PONY RIDERS N3 - Open to all CN/CE horses.
MUSICAL KUR DRESSAGE – See Adult competition no. 22 & 23

DRESSAGE MUSICAL KUR – See adult competition's 22 & 23

18. NOVICE DRESSAGE SANEF 2007 N4 – Open to all N horses.
19. ELEMENTARY DRESSAGE SANEF 2007 E2 – Open to JN/N/JE/E horses that have not entered competition numbers 11 & 17.
20. ELEMENTARY DRESSAGE SANEF 2007 E4 – Open to Junior & Adult E / EM horses.
21. E/M DRESSAGE SANEF 2007 EM 1 – Open to JE/E and EM horses
22. MUSICAL KUR SANEF 2007 E – Open to all CE/JE/E/EM horses
23. MUSICAL KUR SANEF 2007 N – Open to all CN/JN/N horses

JUMPING

24. AD WELCOME STAKES – Rule FEI 238.2.2 (AM5)
25. AD COMPETITION IN TWO PHASES – Rule FEI 274 5.2
26. D/C/B WELCOME STAKES - Rule FEI 238 2.2 (AM5) {C and B horses successive handicap}
27. D/C/B 21 POINTS ACCUMULATOR – Rule NAMEF 8.12.2.1 {C and B horses successive handicap}

SPECIAL COMPETITIONS:

28. TEAM JUMPING – consists of any 4 riders (at least 1 child, 1 junior, 1 adult) from any club & 4 heights (70cm; 80cm; 90cm; 100cm). Jump-off against the clock for the nominated best rider from team – (heights to be raised by 10cm per rider).
29. MINI DERBY – 1m – Rule REI 238 2.2 Table A (AM5) Open for CC, JAD, JD, AD horses
30. MAXI DERBY – 1.10M – Rule FEI 238 2.2 (AM5) Open for JC,D,C,B, {C and B horses successive handicap}

MATERIALPRUFUNG & RIDING HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP 2007

31. 3 – 4 YEAR OLD HORSES (Qualifier for competition 33)
32. 5 – 6 YEAR OLD HORSES (Qualifier for competition 33)
33. RIDING HORSE CHAMPIONSHIPS – Open to 5 best Namibian bred horses of competition No.31 & No.32. Horses competing in No. 31 – 33 do not have to be registered with NAMEF. **A Copy of pedigree from NWHS to accompany any horse that qualifies for No.33.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All competitions will be ridden according to the rules & regulations of FEI and NAMEF.
2. CLOSING DATE IS 13 AUGUST 2007 (DATE OF STAMP) – PAYMENT INCLUDED.
3. Entry fee per competition = N\$25.00
4. Stabling fee is N\$30.00 per horse for the show. Competitors must supply own feed, water troughs, and bedding
5. Every participant is required to contribute N\$20.00 for medical aid.
6. Bank deposits/Direct Bank transfers shall be preferred and faxed accompanied with entry form to 062 501 195 or email to fajtjie@mweb.com.na

7. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times
8. All horses must be in possession of a valid NAMEF or other NF horse passport & be vaccinated against Equine Influenza and African Horse Sickness, endorsed by a veterinarian. Horses and riders must be registered at Namef or another federation member of the FEI. The organizers may request proof. (Except horses competing in competition's 1-4; 31,32,33)
9. All P dressage riders, may not compete in any E / EM dressage. All dressage riders are requested to please bring their own scribe and caller.
10. Horse trailers or trucks may only be parked at places allocated by the organizing committee.
11. Private accommodation cannot be arranged. If camping is required please contact Mrs Bezuidenhout on 0812260468 or 0812075939.
12. Neither the organizers, nor NAMEF or their officials can be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by/to horse, by/to rider, the public or their property.
13. The organizer reserves the right to cancel, combine or split events, depending on the number of entries, amend the time schedule mentioned in the program of events, change the starting order of riders in competitions in case of need, and postpone or cancel the tournament in part or totally, in case of unforeseen or special circumstances.
14. 25% of Entry Fee's and 15% of all prize money will be paid to NAMEF.
15. If more the one horse is entered in a competition, the starting order should be stated on the entry form.
16. No cross entries allowed.
17. Tack and bits must comply with the relevant NAMEF rules and regulations.
18. Any horse may not compete in more than 4 competitions in Children classes or 3 competitions in Junior or Adult classes on any 1 day.

RETURN OF FLOATING TROPHIES:

Floating trophies have to be returned by latest 8th September 2007 in a clean and polished condition.
